Articles General Requirements

Articles submitted are reviewed and accepted on the understanding that they have not been published elsewhere. The length of articles should not be more that 5,000 words (final version). All manuscripts submission should be written in English Language. The original manuscript should be typed one sided, 1.5-line spacing, single column with font size 12pt (Times New Roman). Paper size should be A4 (21.0cm x 29.7cm) with 2 cm margins on the left, right and bottom and 3 cm for the top.

1. PAPER STRUCTURE

- a. Abstract: Not more than 250 words
- **b. Keywords**: Not more than five (5)
- c. Article main body:
 - i. Introduction Study area (where applicable)
 - ii. Material & method
 - iii. Results & Discussion
 - iv. Conclusion
 - v. Recommendation
 - vi. Acknowledgements (where applicable)
 - vii. References
- **d. Headings and Sub-headings:** should be based on important index, subject matter and numbered serially for reference purposes (1.1, 1.2, 1.2.1 etc.)
- e. Figures/Tables: To be properly identified/referenced within the paper; table title above and figure title below.
- **f. References/Citations:** Should follow American Psychology Association (APA) 9th edition manual style.

2. PUBLICATION FEES

Nigerian authors will be requested to pay the sum of $\frac{1}{2}$ 25,000.00 as publication fee once their article is accepted. Foreign authors are expected to pay the sum of USD 70.
